This article briefly describes and then sets out in a comparison table most all Internet and online sources for U.S. federal and state legislative and regulatory information. It begins by describing subscription sources and then follows with non-subscription ones.

<u>CQ Roll Call</u>, via its CQ Weekly has been reporting on Congress for over 65 years. In recent years CQ.com, as well as GalleryWatch.com and Capitol Advantage were purchased by Roll Call, which is a subsidiary of the Economist Group, and their various product lines were merged. CQ now has an unrivaled collection of legislative tracking and reporting services on both the federal and state level.

<u>LexisNexis</u>, owned by Reed Elsevier, is one of the largest legal and news services in the world and has substantial legislative and regulatory information on both the federal and state levels with a new topical tab that puts all this information in one accessible place.

<u>Westlaw</u> is a legal research service of Thomson Reuters with a wealth of legislative and regulatory information on the federal and state level, including over 20,000 legislative histories from the GAO.

<u>Accelus</u> and its Capitol Watch legislative database is also part of the Thomson-Reuters family (above).

<u>BloombergLaw</u> is the legal research and news arm of Bloomberg L.P., and it also provides federal and state laws, regulations, analysis, and tracking services.

<u>BNA</u>, recently purchased by Bloomberg publishes more than 300 in depth news products that report, by subject, on Congressional, agency, and other actions.

<u>DSCS</u> or DataStream Content Solutions, owned by the Dolan Company, has a host of legislative and regulatory products including a 50 state legislative and regulatory impact monitoring service.

Fednet.net makes available live or archival audio and video coverage of all House and Senate floor debates and selected congressional hearings.

<u>Federal News Service</u> (fednews.com), now part of The Dolan Company, provides verbatim transcripts of many Congressional hearings and all prepared Committee testimonies as well as other products.

<u>HeinOnline</u>.org, a service of the William S. Hein & Co. has available digital libraries of the complete Congressional Record, Federal Register, C.F.R., U.S. Statutes at Large, as well as hundreds of legislative histories, and other materials.

<u>Leadership Directories</u>. publishes many government directories including the *Congressional Yellow Book, Federal Yellow Book,* and *State Yellow Book.* As a package subscription all 14 directories are available on the Internet or CD-ROM.

<u>*LLMC.com*</u> (Law Library Microfom Consortium) is a non-profit cooperative of libraries with many legislative microform collections; some of them online.

<u>*LobbyistsInfo*</u> provides multiple tools for finding lobbyists by issue, industry, organization, etc.

<u>National Journal</u>, known for publishing a weekly policy and political magazine, also provides online Congressional products like *NJ Daily, Daybook*, *Hotline, Almanac of American Politics*, and more.

<u>Paratext</u> has created links in historical indices to other web products (*Readex Serial Set; Cong. Globe*).

<u>Penny Hill</u> Press provides free abstracts of most Congressional Research Service (CRS) reports (from at least 1995 forward) and for a fee will send out selected PDF or paper copies of the full text. Its products are also available through CQ Roll Call.

<u>ProQuest</u> is a leading provider of research and archival material through electronic and microfom resources including the recently purchased <u>CIS</u> Congressional product line from LexisNexis, which provides abstracts and full text of the historical Congressional Record, as well as hearings, reports, CRS reports, and more. <u>Proquest Legislative Insight</u> provides thousands of legislative histories from 1929. <u>*Readex*</u>, a division of NewsBank, has meticulously compiled a highly indexed digital edition of the U.S. Congressional Serial Set, 1817-1994.

<u>StateNet</u>, a subsidiary of LexisNexis, provides a host of legislative and regulatory tracking services and documents for the 50 states, the District of Columbia and the U.S. government.

<u>*TheCapitol.Net*</u> offers Congressional related courses, publications and training opportunities. It also provides a host of free statistical and other information related to Congress.

A variety of other companies offer federal and state statutory and regulatory documents and research products including <u>FastCase</u>, <u>Loislaw</u>, <u>VersusLaw</u>, <u>TheLaw.net</u>, and the <u>NationalLawLibrary</u> (itislaw).

In addition there are a variety of companies that provide 50 state legislative and regulatory monitoring and reporting services as well as advocacy assistance, including <u>MultiState</u> Associates, <u>StateScape</u>, <u>Regscan</u>, <u>LISA</u>usa.net, and <u>Stateside</u> Associates.

In describing non-subscription sources a good place to start is the Library of Congress (LoC), especially its legislative home page, <u>*THOMAS*</u>, which has bill status information going back to 1973, as well as the text of bills (from 1989), the Congressional Record; Committee reports (from 1995) and info on treaties, appropriations, and Presidential nominations. Linked to *THOMAS*, LoC has also digitized early (pre-1876) Congressional documents in its website called *A Century of Lawmaking for A New Nation*.

<u>FDsys</u>, is the U.S. Government Printing Office's next generation electronic documents platform. It includes thousands of official legislative documents (laws, bills, reports, hearings, etc.) and regulatory documents (Federal Register, CFR, executive orders, etc.) in PDF, text, and other formats.

The <u>U.S. House of Representatives</u> (House.gov) and the <u>U.S. Senate</u> (Senate.gov) each have their own Web sites with links to member, committee, and leadership pages as well as other information such as scheduling information and roll call votes. Many of the committee Web pages include the prepared statements of witnesses in committee hearings as well as committee Webcast archives.

The <u>American Presidency Project</u> (presidency.ucsb .edu/) provides executive orders (from 1826), signing statements (from 1929) and other documents.

BioGuide (http://bioguide.congress.gov). The *Biographical Directory of the United States Congress*, 1774 – Present has a search template for entering all past and present members. Also available in PDF and hardback via the U.S. Government Printing Office.

<u>C-Span</u>.org provides free videos of recent and live broadcasts of Congressional hearings and other events and charges fees for its video archives (since 1987).

<u>*CapitolHearings.org*</u>, a service of C-Span offers live audio feeds of Congressional hearings.

The <u>Center on Congress</u> at the University of Indiana promotes events, resources and surveys to assist the public in understanding Congress and representative democracy.

<u>*Congress.org*</u> (sponsored by CQ Roll Call) provides information on public policy issues and tips on effective advocacy.

The <u>Congressional Institute</u> (conginst.org) offers members of Congress ways to serve constituents and ways for constituents to better understand Congress via conferences and online resources.

<u>CongressLink</u>.org, part of the Dirksen Congressional Center, provides a host of links to Congressional information, both government and non-government.

<u>CongressMerge</u>.com, has database products for sale as well as free contact information regarding members of Congress, districts, committees, schedules, and more.

<u>ContactingTheCongress</u>.org provides easy templates and information for contacting members of Congress.

Findlaw.com/casecode/, a service of *Thomson Reuters* (*Westlaw*) provides free (but somewhat dated) editions of the U.S. Code, CFR, & Federal Register.

<u>*GovSpeak*</u> lists U.S. government abbreviations and acronyms with a web link to the agency name.

<u>*GovTrack.us*</u> provides free text and tracking of Congressional bills, members, votes, committees and other services.

<u>*HathiTrust.org*</u> through partner libraries has a huge quantity of cataloged digital books in the public domain such as Congressional hearings. (docs not in PDF; but fully accessible by page turning).

<u>Justia</u>.com provides free access to a host of U.S. legal resources including U.S. Code, CFR, Federal Register, state codes, court cases, and more.

The <u>Legal Information Institute</u> (LII) at Cornell provides the U.S. Code, C.F.R, and many other publications in table of contents format with direct links to sections (http://www.law.cornell.edu/).

Legistorm provides salary and financial disclosure data on members of Congress and their staff.

The *National <u>Archives</u>.gov* holds the records of Congress, and, through its Office of the Federal Register, provides the Federal Register, presidential documents (including disposition status and links to *Executive Orders*), and other information.

<u>OpenCongress</u>.org presents Congressional bills, votes, members, issues, blogs and other material in terms of popularity, recent actions and other ways.

<u>OpenCRS</u>.com provides free access to thousands (not always the most current version) of CRS reports written exclusively for Congress by the Congressional Research Service of the Library of Congress.

<u>OpenSecrets.org</u>, the Center for Responsive Politics, tracks money in U.S. politics and its effect on elections and public policy.

The <u>Political Graveyard</u>.com provides biographical information on past U.S. politicians.

<u>*Project Vote Smart*</u> (vote-smart.org) provides candidate votes, stands, & campaign finance information.

<u>*Regulations.gov*</u> has Fed Register data from 2006 and permits users to post and view reg. comments.

<u>Rutgers</u> Law Library (lawlibrary.rutgers.edu) has digitized thousands of U.S. Congressional documents from 1970 to 1998 and made them freely available.

The <u>Sunlight Foundation</u>.com/resources sponsors numerous projects and grantees that provide tools and Websites for greater political transparency.

<u>TheGreenPapers</u>.com provides a wealth of facts and tables on the Federal government, state governments and politics, including tables on Congressional sessions and Presidential administrations.

The U.S. State Department has a great deal of *Treaty Affairs* information (state.gov/s/l/treaty/).

The <u>U.S. Congress Votes Database</u>, published by the Washington Post, lets you browse every congressional vote since 1991.

<u>Voter Information Services</u> (vis.org) provides advocacy group ratings on members of Congress voting records.

The <u>*WhiteHouse.gov*</u> provides current Presidential executive orders, signing statements, policy positions, <u>*OMB*</u> circulars, budget plans, and other materials.

There are also free or nearly free news services like <u>RollCall.com</u>, WashingtonPost.com/<u>Politics</u>, <u>The Hill</u> CNN.com/<u>Politics</u>/, <u>C-Span</u>.org, <u>Stateline.org</u> and other news services that largely focus on politics.

Finally, <u>LLSDC's Legislative Source Book</u> (LLSDC.org/sourcebook) where this publication is housed, also provides current legislative activity news, Federal legislative history links, state links, tables, and guides to the U.S. Code, the Federal Register, the Congressional Record, and other information.

The comparison table that follows attempts to show all the subscription and non-subscription providers described above in eight different columns and in some 90 categories of information. It is limited in the kinds of information it can convey. At a glance, however, it will reveal what kind of legislative and regulatory information is or is not available from each provider, and the dates of coverage. Categories that are not preceded by the word "state" generally concern only federal information. Sources may differ significantly in cost, comprehensiveness, accuracy, timeliness and efficiency of use.
