■ The *American State Papers* (1789-1838) are a collection of early government documents that are bound in a series of volumes on specialized topics including Indian Affairs, Military Affairs, Naval Affairs, Foreign Relations, Public Lands, Commerce and Navigation, Claims, Finance, Post Office Department, and Miscellaneous.
